ing a dozen miles from ice-capped peaks to terminate in cliffs of ice towering hundreds of feet above the water. You will also see spectacular waterfalls and wildlife. Tomorrow you will leave Anchorage for Denali.

This morning you will travel to Denali. Your evening will be spent at the Cabin Dinner Theater. Enjoy a night of fun, comedy, entertainment and food! Overnight in Denali.
