ITINERARY

In this day trip, you will get an up-close glimpse of a heritage that continues to impact northwest Missouri and beyond. It will start in King City where, in 1856, four years before the opening of the Pony Express, John Pittsenbarger "pitched his tent," as history tells us, on the spot that is now King City. At the end of your tour, you will find yourself at historic Conception Abbey, a Benedictine monastery established by monks from Engelberg, Switzerland in 1873 in order to minister the settlers of the area.

Begin at the Tri-County Museum in the retired Burlington-Northern train depot. See the artifacts and exhibits that will illustrate the history and development of northwest Missouri.

Tour the Bluegrass Ridge Wind Farm. Twenty-seven massive turbines reach 262 feet into the air, and each of the three blades is 140 feet long.

After a brief talk on the history of the Abbey, tour the Basilica of the Immaculate Conception. You will also have an opportunity to visit the gift shop.

Return home this afternoon with a new understanding of northwest Missouri.
