DAY ONE—TWO—En-route



Day One:

Begin with pickups in Omaha, Council Bluffs, Holton and Topeka. Make a short stop at the Oklahoma City Memorial. The Memorial is dedicated to educating visitors about the impact of violence, informing about events surround-

ing the bombing, and inspiring hope and healing through lessons learned by those affected. Spend your first night in Del City, OK .

Day Two:

Today you will travel to San Antonio. Take time

to explore the Riverwalk. The San Antonio Riverwalk is a network of walkways around the San Antonio River, linking several major attractions one story beneath downtown San Antonio. Spend the first of three nights in San Antonio, TX.

DAY THREE— San Fernando Cathedral, King William District



Day Three:

After breakfast you will start with a visit to the Institute of Texan Cultures. The Institute is dedicated to enhancing the understanding of cultural history, science, and technology

and their influence upon the people of Texas. Then visit the San Fernando Cathedral. This church was planned to be the center of the life of the city. Stop by El Mercado for lunch, browsing and shopping. These 32

shops give you a taste of an authentic Mexican market. Take a narrated cruise down the Riverwalk. Continue your day with a tour of the King William District, San Antonio's oldest historic neighborhood.

DAY FOUR—McNay Art Museum, The Alamo



Day Four:

This morning visit McNay Art Museum, the first modern-art museum in Texas. Browse the 19th & 20th Century paintings, and prints. Spend time shopping at La Villita.

This historic riverside settlement is now home to artisans, small shops and restaurants. Today you will also visit the Alamo. First see an IMAX film, "The Alamo . . . The Price of Freedom". Then tour the Alamo Mission.

This afternoon visit the Missions National Historic Park. In 1718 Franciscans and Spanish representatives established the first mission. Within 13 years, five were located along the San Antonio River. Browse the Visitor's

Center, Museum and book store. Watch the movie *Gente de Razon* telling the story of the native people of 18th-century south Texas, their role in colonizing New Spain, and the results of entering the Spanish Missions. See

Mission Concepcion, Mission San Jose; known as the “Queen of the Missions”, Mission San Juan Capistrano and Mission Espada.

Day Five:

This morning you will leave San Antonio. Visit the Texas State

Capitol in Austin. Completed in 1888 as a winning design from a national competition, the Capitol’s style is Renaissance Revival, based on the architecture of 15th century Italy and characterized by classical order, round arches and symmetrical

composition. The Texas Capitol is the largest in gross square footage of all state capitols and second in total size only to the National Capitol in Washington DC. It also rises 15 feet higher

than it’s Washington DC counterpart. You will travel out of Texas and into Oklahoma. Tonight you will have time to spend at Bricktown in Oklahoma City. Then overnight in Del City, OK.

Day Six:

This evening you will return home with new friends and experiences that will last a life time.
