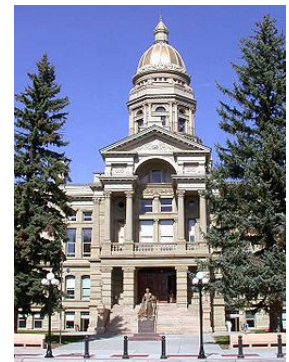
DAY SIX—Cheyenne, WY
